

Site Technician (#LIC28-0929ISLD)

You will have the opportunity to work as part of a multidisciplinary team that is reshaping how internet and phone companies design and deploy fiber optic networks throughout cities. Encepta's emphasis is on how you get the fiber optic cables from A to B using telephone poles or conduits as support structures. We do not address the higher-level networking and actual transmission of the signal through the fiber. Our technology-centric approach to telecommunications outside plant design is built upon the use of tablets and our proprietary apps/software to collect measurements and GPS locations of the poles.

As part of our field inspection and audit team, you would use Encepta's proprietary software apps to complete field audits and inspections to ensure that designs are built to code and provide key information used by our designers to meet customer's requirements. Experience in telecommunications is not necessary but can be a benefit in identifying various telecommunication cables and structures.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Complete field inspections and audits to gather relevant telecom cable and structural information related to telephone pole lines and confirm compliancy with standards;
- Complete field inspections and audits related to telephone vaults, manholes and underground infrastructure in order to confirm compliance with standards;
- Liaison with design techs to ensure all information has been gathered for each job and to problem solve any issues which may arise;
- Liaison with software team to continually update and improve proprietary software;
- Liaison with developers and third-parties to confirm build schedules and ensure construction is completed according to standards;
- Enter all audited information and relevant inspection documentation into proprietary software to be uploaded to database for processing;
- Operate and maintain company vehicles and equipment related to audit and inspection work;
- Identify potential safety hazards at job locations and liaison with traffic controllers to set up flagging where necessary;
- Maintain professional company standards when dealing with customers or the public;
- Research and develop new processes and technology;
- Uphold and promote adherence to Training, Operating and Health & Safety Procedures; and
- Other duties as requested by manager.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Willingness to work outside or in confined spaces such as manholes in all seasonal weather situations;
- Knowledge of various cable types such as fibre optical, coax and copper;
- Valid Class 5 driver's license with experience driving in all weather conditions;
